

# TOUCH FOOTBALL - 20 Years Later

Bear with me because I'm old and I'm senile. You know what that means don't you? It means that when I hear the word "TROJANS", I think of football. Not only do I no longer worry about protecting "it", I hardly remember what "wrapping it up" will protect "it" from. Actually, I'm not sure that I even remember what "it" is. Anyway, that's another story. The point of this little exercise is because I believe that the recognition of milestones is extremely important to a league such as ours. And although I didn't join the league until 1977, I just couldn't let this 20th anniversary go by without reminiscing about a few of the football related incidents that have made this game and this League such an important part of my life.

September 1977 - My first game on a beautiful Sunday morning at PES. Talk about ultra nervous! We're playing a team called the Millidgeville Cubs. "Wow! They must be good - they've got a very athletic looking black guy named Carl White quarterbacking.

Well - so much for stereotypes! But then again, I haven't seen him in the shower yet!...........Hey this isn't so tough! Tom James just threw me a 50 yard TD pass. I think I'm going to like this game."

November 1977 - "Can you believe it! We beat Mike Butler's (1976 Trojan QB) team in the final. Felt so good! But now it doesn't feel so good! After driving for 15 hours in a van with a bunch of guys, 1 girl, and too much beer, we just lost 48-0 to the 3 time Canadian champs on a frozen field with our "drunk" QB. (it wasn't Tom - the only thing he threw all weekend was chicken balls at Jerry McGrath)!..... I came home by Air Canada with our "drunken QB" !!!

## Spring 1978 - Amazing! We competed (?) in a "National" tournament so we get invited

 to pig out at the Saint John Sports recognition banquet! They even gave us a nice certificate that called us "athletes." My oh my - the word "athlete" is thrown around loosely these days. They even gave one to Peter (our drunk QB).About 1979 - Our arch rival, Mike Butler, took a night off of work and brought his BB gun to our game. Seems that he wanted to use Carl Olsen for target practice. I'm sure that if Carl had only known, he would have accommodated Mike by taking the night off work as well!

Early 1980's (winters) - "Man - it's been nearly two months without football! Time for our annual "SNOW BOWL" against the Walking Wounded. I wish Tom would stop throwing snowballs at Jerry!"

Mid 1980's - That was a great season Kevin and Brendan. You guys didn't lose a single game until you had to face the powerful Trojans in the semi final on Saturday. Did you have to pay that photographer who you had prearranged to take your team portrait at the championship game on Sunday?

1986 - "Our first playoff championship since 1977. How can we celebrate? How about a team video. Yeah! We'll write some lyrics and do a music video! Yeah! Sort of like "We are the World" but with attitude! Yeah! Let's make it a "rap" video! Yeah! And then
we'll show it at the League banquet! Yeah!" But we chickened out! (even after we edited out the scene with Tom and Carl depicting an act that is illegal in 47 American States).

1987 - Touch Bowl '87 in Halifax. "This tournament has come a long way in 10 years. I mean these guys have incredible organizational skills. Great football! Great entertainment! How did a little city like Halifax ever put on a tournament this big? Can you imagine Saint John ever trying to do something like this? .....Fat chance!"

1989 - "Carl White wants to apply to host Touch Bowl '90!"..... "You've got to be kidding. We can't handle that. I mean we're talking 60-70 teams. How are they going to get here? Where do we get the refs? We don't have enough fields! We just can't do it. It's too big!"

Volunteers Wind up Party, November 1990 - Tournament Director Donna Kuzyk (mega babe) calls Touch Bowl '90 the best organized of the many Touch Bowls that she has presided over. And she must have meant it because she fully endorsed our application to host Touch Bowl '93. "Thank you Carl for believing in us and in our City."

1992 - "Carl White wants to apply to host Touch Bowl ' 93 !"...... "Piece of Cake!"

Well, as you can imagine, I could go on. In fact, I think I will. But I'll be brief.
I can't believe that I haven't mentionned our team's most loyal fan. Until our kids were born, my wife, Gloria, came out to every game and did our stats. Most of the time, she would drag our somewhat reluctant team mascot (EXPOCAT) dressed in his Trojan sweater. I must admit that it always really bugged me that Gloria's appreciation trophies from the team were always bigger than any trophy that we had won on the field.

Nor did I mention the appreciation that I felt as I watched teammate Chuck Edison intentionally drop a TD pass late in the 4th quarter on the last game of the regular season in 1981 so that I would have one more chance to win the League scoring championship. (Was I subtle enough in getting that in there?)

And then there were the Trojan poems to celebrate those special victories. And the bake sales (thanks Tom). And those annual invitational tournaments in Halifax and PEI (I really didn't have anything to do with that PEI flag stolen off the Petro Canada Station next to the hotel). And the birthday cake for Carl White and Moody Dumas. (we couldn't find candles so we decorated it with candy - "black babies")

As you can tell, I have accumulated a lot of great memories during the past 19 years. To each of you who have been a part of making those memories, I thank you. And to those players who are new to the league, I thank you for being a part of tomorrow's memories. I sincerely hope that this game can provide you with as much satisfaction as it has given me.

In a repeat of last year's A DIVISION final, the Raiders finished an unblemished season with a convincing win over the Ten Pennies. Despite an injury that had limited his running game for the entire season, QB Derek Dixon once again led the Raider offence with his precision passing attack (at least that is what he told me!!!). The Raiders grabbed an early $6-0$ lead on a stop and go from Dixon to Peter McIntyre. Three 2nd quarter Tds by Tony Brothers (2) and Glen Smith (1) and a Derek Dixon single point conversion gave the Raiders a comfortable 25-0 lead late in the 1st half. However, Tom O'Reilly scored a Ten Penny TD late in the half to give his team a glimmer of hope. That glimmer became brighter in the 3rd quarter when Ten Penny QB Paul Stackhouse scored a major to bring his team within 13. However, Tony Hogan's TD (and Ken Lawrence SR's single point conversion) in the 4th quarter put the game away for the defending champs. Defensively, Glen Smith played a major role in the Raider win by intercepting 4 passes on the day.
"B" DIVISION FINAL
THE "AVE" 46 GS GRANNAN'S TROJANS 0
From the opening kickoff, the AVE moved the ball effectively deep into Trojan territory on each of their first two possessions. However, the Trojan defence held firm within their own 15 yard line and the first quarter finished without any scoring. Denis McCarty opened the floodgates early in the 2nd quarter on a 65 yard pass and run from quarterback Doug Eadle. Before the end of the first half, the AVE had increased their lead to 20-0. The Trojans hopes for a comeback were crushed early in the 3rd quarter when after moving the ball well over center field, Ed McCarty picked off a tipped pass and returned it 70 yards for a TD and an insurmountable AVE lead. In total, Ed led the winners with 3 Tds and 2 single point conversions, while brother Denis scored 3 TDS and a single point conversion. George Eadle rounded out the scoring with 7 points as the AVE won their first ever championship.
