

Touch Football Begins Sunday

Saint John Touch Football League swings into another season beginning Sunday with 10 teams seeing action.

The league, split up into two divisions, will see the 'A' squads playing a 15-game schedule and the 'B' teams playing 14 contests.

It all culminates with the league finals beginning Nov. 7. Prior to that any of the teams wishing to represent the city at the national championships can get into an elimination tourney near the end of October.

On Sunday at Shamrock Park, defending champion Runners' World tangles with the Cooler Kings at 10 a.m. while the other 'A' division game pits 1880 Trojans against the Rockets at 11:30.

In the 'B' section, three games will be played at Princess Elizabeth School field.

At 10 a.m., the Walking Wounded face Shoppers Drug mart, followed by the Bucaneers-Raiders clash at 11:30 and the Blues and the Broco's Broncos contest at 1:30 p.m.

Touch Football Season Opens

Shutouts were the order of the day as the Saint John Touch Football League opened its season on two fronts Sunday.

In 'A' Division play at Shamrock Park 1880 Trojans whipped the Rockets 60-0 while defending champion Runner's World trounced the Kooler Kings 40-6.

In the 'B' Division at Princess Elizabeth School Field, Yukon Jacks blanked the Raiders 21-0. Broncos whitewashed the Blues 32-0 and Parrrtown Walking Wounded 23-8 over Shopper's Drug Mart.

Dave McGowan had two touchdowns and a couple of two-point converts to lead the 1880 rout. Carl Olson and Moody Dumas also had two majors with Olson adding a two-point convert.
